The koel is found throughout the Indian sub-continent. It is a bird about the size of a crow but with a longer tail and a more slender body. The male bird is black in colour with a yellowish - green bill and red eyes. The female bird is spotted with white dots.

The koel is entirely arboreal - meaning never coming down to ground. It largely survives on figs of of banyan, gular, pipal and other berries. It also eats insects and caterpillers besides, occasionally, the eggs of other birds.

The koel never builds a nest of its own; it is parasitic on the nests of other birds, especially the crow. To outwit the crow,both the male and the female koel work together. The male starts singing near a crow's nest while the female stays hidden. The crow chases the male koel away and meanwhile, the female koel flies to the crow's unguarded nest and lays her eggs in it.
